- · Study level: PhD
- Limit of participants: 30 (10 per university). Application does not guarantee enrolment in the course.
- Assessment methods and criteria: any, it depends on the decision of lecturer.

- The order of applications is decisive (the rule: first come, first served).

- Once the recruitment process is complete, your home university will inform you whether you have been accepted. Then, your account on the Moodle platform will be created.
