Obtaining the Digital Certificate

1. [Previous considerations and browser configuration](#) • To avoid problems with the request or download of the certificate, you have to consult this section.
2. Download the FNMT Configurator from this [link](#)
3. Then, you will have to fill in the following [form](#)
4. Once completed, you will receive a "Request Code" in the indicated e-mail account, which will be required at the time of proving your identity (step 5) and later when downloading your certificate (step 6).
5. [Proof of identity at a Registry Office](#) • You will have to go to one of the Registry Offices to prove your identity, presenting the "Application Code" from the previous step and your ID card.
