



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CURRENT SITUATION

- Pandemic evolution is **stagnated**, without significant increases in incidence, but also without decreases in the curve of new infections
- **Uncertainty** and changing rules. Curfew at eleven o'clock at night. Capacity limitations. It is not allowed to travel outside of Cantabria without a justified cause
- Whenever possible the UC delivers **face-to-face** teaching combined with online classes
- Students are informed upon arrival of the recommendations on **prevention** and on how to proceed in case of emergency

Erasmus+

- What is Erasmus+? EU's Programme to support education, training, youth and sport
- Open to Programme Countries and **Partner Countries**
- Participants can complement their education, they get to know another university system, another culture and to develop linguistic and personal competences
- **Individual support** and **travel costs support** to participants
- Academic **recognition** is a key element in this program
- After the mobility, participants **return** to their sending institution in order to **complete** their studies or activities
