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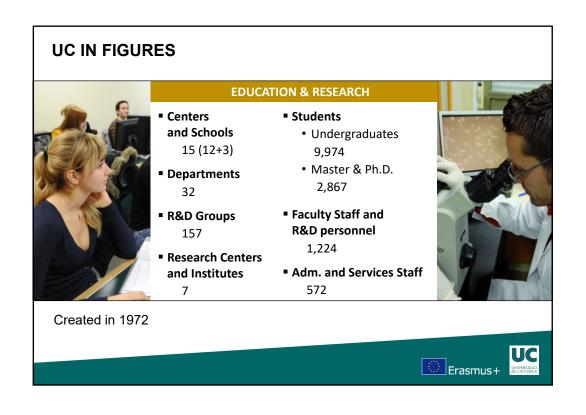


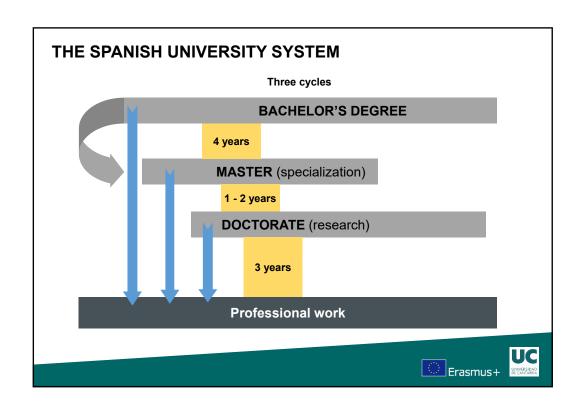


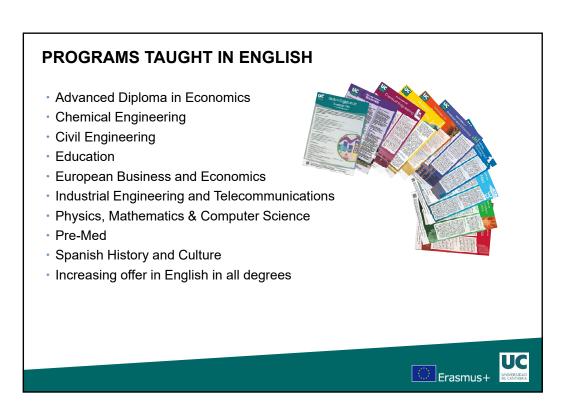

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### **CURRENT SITUATION**

- Pandemic evolution is **stagnated**, without significant increases in incidence, but also without decreases in the curve of new infections
- Uncertainty and changing rules. Curfew at eleven o'clock at night.
   Capacity limitations. It is not allowed to travel outside of Cantabria without a justified cause
- Whenever possible the UC delivers **face-to-face** teaching combined with online classes
- Students are informed upon arrival of the recommendations on **prevention** and on how to proceed in case of emergency

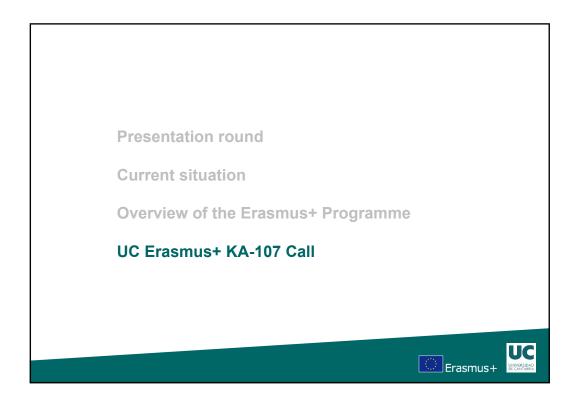
