1	Grammar: Subject/object questions. Verbal tenses. Verb patterns: verb+Ing or infinitive. Modals. Conditionals
2	Speaking: discussions about various topics
3	Listening: understanding main ideas of a text; short predictable conversations; descriptions; mass media products; professional-oriented conversations.
4	Reading: different text typologies in different textual formats; continuous and discontinuous texts.
5	Writing: production of written texts meeting the students' needs through different textual formats and requirements.
6	Communicative interaction: a) microfunctions like expressing and discovering attitudes; persuasion; socializing; discourse structuring; communication repair etc., and b) macrofunctions like description; narration; commentary; exposition; explanation etc.
