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3.1 LEARNING OUTCOMES

-- Nursing Childhood Module:

Plan care ensuring the right to dignity, privacy, personal rights, confidentiality and decision-making capacity of the child and his / her family.

Provide care in the different stages of childhood within the family context and in the social environment where the child develops, either to achieve optimal health or to recover health in case of illness.

Demonstrate skill in the use of specific child material.

Demonstrate skills to promote family involvement in the health-disease process of children and adolescents.

Carry out Health Education for the child and his / her family as well as the people around them during the health and illness process.

Demonstrate skill in applying techniques by establishing a therapeutic relationship with children and their caregivers.

Demonstrate ability to safely administer drugs and other therapies at the infancy stage and in different health and disease situations.

Describe the characteristics of the different stages of childhood and adolescence .

Describe the most frequent health problems in childhood and its manifestations.

Demonstrate the ability to establish an empathetic and respectful relationship with the child and his or her family, in accordance with the child's situation and the child's stage of development.

Demonstrate ability in children's communication and their families favoring the expression of their concerns and interests.

Demonstrate ability to work in a team and communicate effectively with all health personnel .

- Nursing module in mental health:

Guarantee confidentiality, professional secrecy and preserves the privacy during the process of evolution of the care of the person with mental health problems.

Show empathy in the care of women.
Demonstrate skills in the interrelationship with the patient, family or social groups in the care process.
Demonstrate strategies that facilitate the involvement of women and their families in decision making and care.
Care for women with health problems, respecting their values, their rights, their cultural characteristics.
Work respecting the harmonious integration of the functions and activities carried out by the different people who constitute the work team.
Implement specific diagnostic and / or therapeutic procedures (linked health products, medicines) for the adult with health problems.
Recognize the indicators of gender violence risk to act efficiently in prevention , implementing the action protocols.
Implement educational interventions to promote adequate sexual health at different stages of a woman 's life.
Provide care to women at different stages of life within the family and community context , either to achieve optimal health status or to recover health in the event of illness.
Know and assess the nutritional needs of healthy people with health problems throughout the life cycle to promote and reinforce healthy eating patterns.
Identify life-threatening situations and know how to Implement basic and advanced life support maneuvers.
