<p>The Extraordinary Call Exam will include the same structure as the final exam of the ordinary call. The student will have the right to do the exam in extraordinary session with a value of 100% of the grade total recoverable activities of the subject. However, due that the characteristics of the exercises of the continuous assessment allows it, the teachers can authorize the student to deliver it in the call extraordinary, evaluating in this case the subject in the same way as in the ordinary call. As far as possible, the evaluation system for Economics of Social Expenditure has been designed ensuring that the same evaluation activities serve to be carried out face-to-face in the classroom as well as not face-to-face in the event that it is necessary to implement a remote assessment scenario, which would only be resorted to if the health and educational authorities competent authorities so indicate.
