Prof. Nouredine Mouaddib, president and founder of UIR initiated the project with the support of both the Moroccan State and the Diaspora.



Upon royal instructions a 20 hectares land lot in Technopolis has been allocated to UIR.



UIR signed a development contract with the Moroccan State.



From 2012 to 2015 UIR launched 12 Schools with more than 25 accredited programs and received the state's recognition in 2016.



Launch of new schools: Political Science, Aerospace Engineering. UIR inaugurates the first phase of its campus.



His Majesty King Mohammed VI lays the foundation stone of the campus. Launch of UIR's 1st programs in: Business, Information Technology, Preparatory Classes (for Engineering schools) and Executive Education.

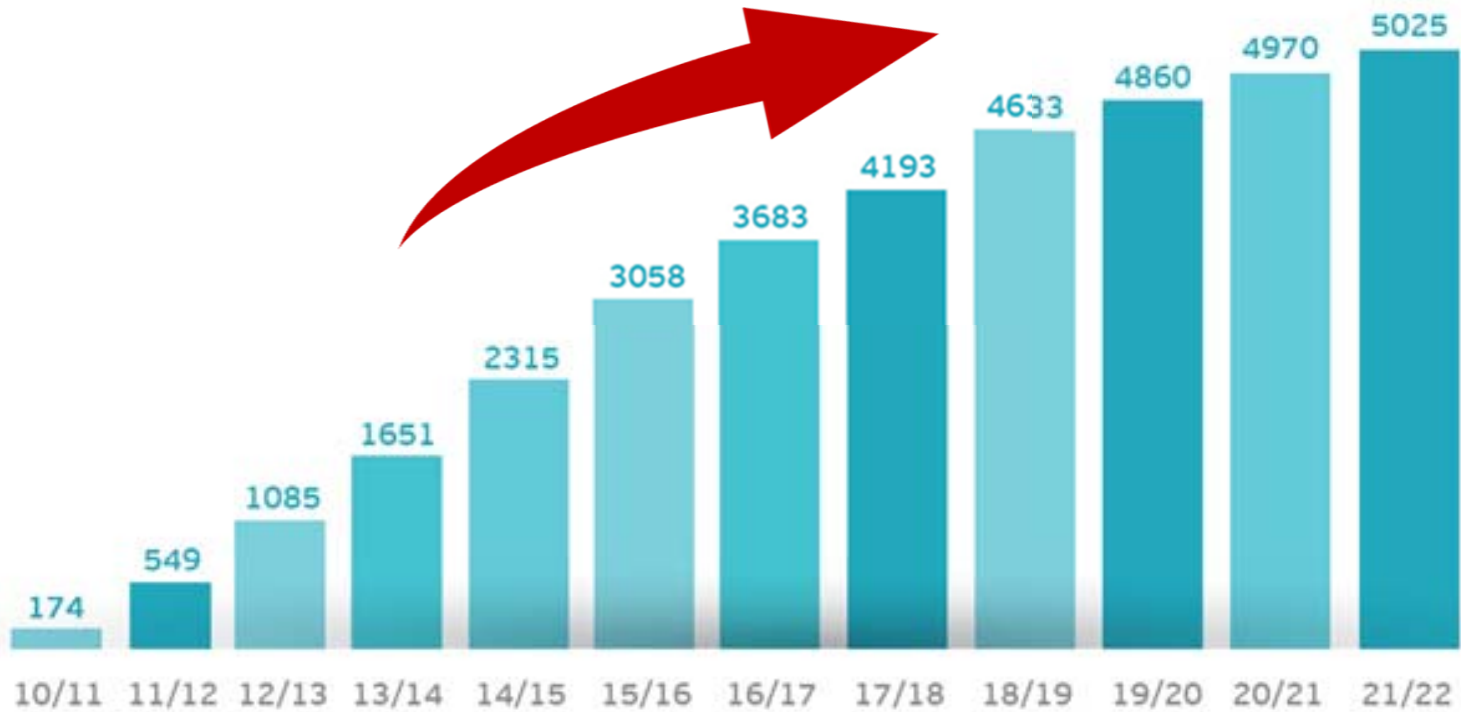

The Chronicle of higher education – August 2010.

This September, the UIR, Which is in the Moroccan capital, received its first 200 students. This University is a public-private partnership. The University aims to have 280 permanent professors and 5000 students by 2020. In addition to management, business, political science and information technology, UIR offers programs in renewable energies, automotive, aeronautical, naval and railway engineering, and architecture.

UIR receives the Trophy of Public Diplomacy («Science» section) in 2011.

The International University of Rabat received the Trophy of Public Diplomacy, «Sciences» section, from the Ambassador of Portugal, who is the Dean of European Ambassadors, in November 2011.

The Trophies of Public Diplomacy aim at rewarding governmental and non-political actors who have contributed to a greater international reach of the Kingdom. They aim to reward the best Moroccan dynamics and to shed light on citizen initiatives as well as to foster understanding and cooperation among peoples, through actions of non-governmental diplomacy.

Report on Knowledge Economy- June 2013 World Bank – ISESCO

The university is an internationally oriented, R&D-driven university, based in the Technopolis of Rabat, an industrial area that aspires to host high-tech industries.

The crucial element of the institution's success is its public funded status. The private management of UIR allows the institution to have more flexibility to recruit talents from the Moroccan diaspora around the world.

UIR receives the IIE Heiskell Awards of Innovation, 2017

The prize was granted to the UIR and its American academic partner Mississippi State University (MSU) by the American institution «IIE» (International Institute for Education) in March 2017.

It rewards UIR and MSU for their innovation in the field of higher education through their double-diploma partnership in the field of automotive and aeronautical engineering, which was successfully launched in 2014.

The International University of Rabat obtained three certifications HQE and two international prizes at World Efficiency on 14/10/2015 in Paris

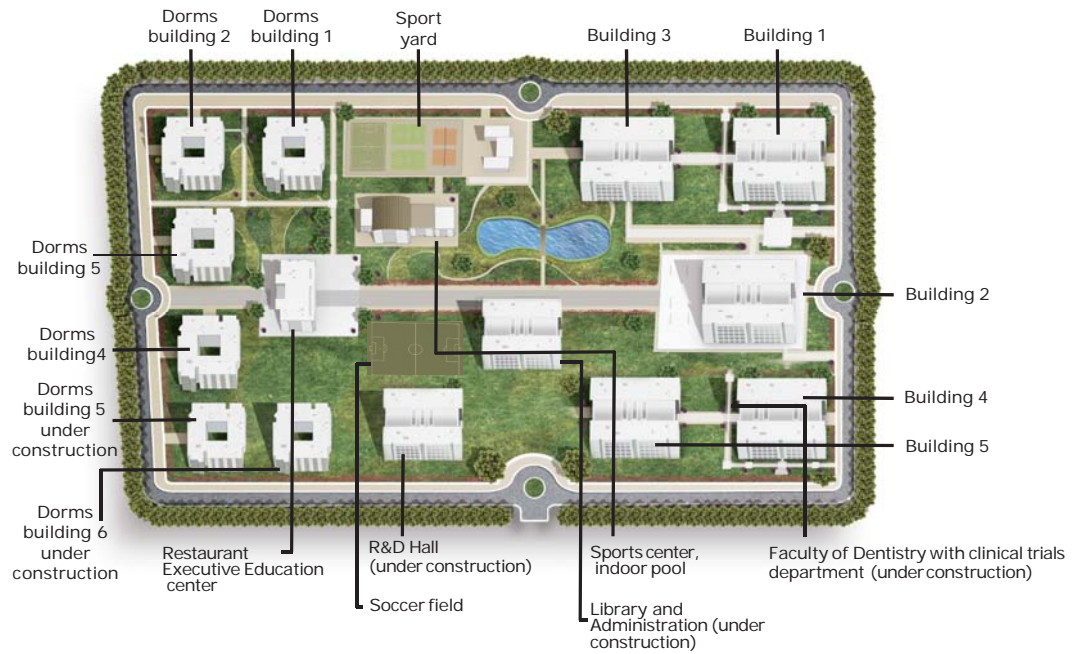

- ✓ The MEdiNA studies program is an area studies program taught within the UIR School of Political Science. The program has a dedicated cohort, who stay for either a semester or an academic year. Credits are fully transferable.
- ✓ Provides quality, interdisciplinary education to majors in humanities and social sciences in the Mediterranean, North African and Middle Eastern region, combined with adjunct artistic, cultural and development studies.
- ✓ Examples of study areas include: political science, business schools, education, art and culture, religion, history and anthropology, language and communication.
